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Well, their would have been in all liklyhood no mistake at the kustom factory as far as installing CTS drivers in a Jensen taged cabinet, plus seeing as the original C12N Jensen drivers are now going for 200 plus! dollars I think with out question those CTS drivers where swapped in. The correct model CTS bass driver will have square, not round magnets and the speaker frame and magnet will be black. If the magnet is round and the driver is unpainted silver than it may be a driver from 1977 not 67.

does your cab have plastic port tubes or real aluminum tubes? The plastic ones are blackish on the inside, late K100 cabs have the plastic tubes.
