I have helped many folks with schematic for the vintage stuff but am unable to hhelp you out with that model. If you go to the new Kustom amplification site and request a schematic for that model from their service dept, they can email you one.

The amp is mono, so its designed for two 8 ohm cabinets which would make for a total load of 4 ohms.

From what I have seen of these small type PA heads they use output packs that are cheap and easy to replace, as I am betting that although you did not post what your problem is, that is the PAs problem, no output.
