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The Eminence Screaming eagle model 12" driver is a very close match to a vintage Jensen C12N driver like what would have come in your amp.

It has a bit less top end and so does not get spiky on top like the Jensen can, plus it handles 50 watts and has a SPL rating of 101, this high rating will make it near twice as loud as the Jensen driver would be.
