While I was waiting I took one off an old cabinet I'm not using. It slid right on there no problem-same screw holes same footprint. Then another one popped up on ebay. This one is a Kustom electronics logo where as the first one is a Kustom by Ross, so I bought it too thinking that the cabinet probably isn't that old. Well I was right. The Ross logo has the screw holes spaced a little bit closer. It also has double lines on either side. I thought they were interchangeable, but not without a fight. Keith.
