I have been doing some deeper digging on this Altec stuff since I have 4 drivers that I need to re-cone and this is what I have found.
Any of the drivers with the II ending in there model have the up rated voice coil that went from 100 watts rms up to 150.
The H used in the model number tells the frequency response goes from some 35hz up to 8K, others are manly Bass drivers that top out at 3500hz, but there are some small differences in low end spec that I can not pin down with the info I have found.
There are however some big differences in the Vs spec on some of the low frequency drivers with some needing over double the cabinet cu Ft area!
