I didn't find the amp your talking about on ebay, but in the first series of Kustom amps after they dropped the T&R the bass II amp is a 60 watt rms power output into a 8 ohm load. Kustom didn't make a 2x12 bass cab in that series. What you may have is the head matched to a 2x10 PA cab that has replaced speakers that are 8 ohm and both speakers presenting a 4 ohm load.
