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It's a unbalanced signal output jack.

It can supply about 3 volts of signal level to a old time tape recorder or to a power amp.

In terms of feeding a power amp since you would be going in to the amp unbalanced you would only have enough drive signal to push the power to about 1/2 its full rated output wattage.

You could also consider this output from the amp a effect send, so you could then go out of a effect , pad it down and go back into the second channel of the Kustom if you where not using it.
