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The 150 series of Kustom amps wants a 8 ohm speaker load to output its full 75 watts of clean RMS power.

You could hook it up to a 16 ohm load safely, but you will then only have 1/2 of that 75 watts the amp was made to output.

Do not hook it up to a 4 ohm load unless you only play the amp at very low volumes !
