It's a kasino lounge guitar amp. It's the pc5131rev-o board. It's fried. I replaced the 1n2069 200 v zener diodes already, replaces the two transistors, and I've replaced the 5349 diodes too. But now it's humming really loudly for a few seconds, then blows the fuse. When I first got it you could see where them white zener diodes had got super hot but it worked for a short time. Now after replacing all That. It hums really loud like I said before and then it blows the fuse. I think the pc5131rev-O is the power board for the entire amp. None of the effects work either.
