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Hello and welcome!

Yes that model had 3 bass controls each covering a certain frequency range. Think of it like a graphic EQ, but with pots instead of sliders.

I am to this day surprised that more of these amps were not bought by bass players back then just due to that great EQ section this model Kustom had!

If it were not for the fact that I already had my K250 I would have bought one for sure even though it would not match my 3-15 T & R cab.

You can change out the power cable and it will not devalue the amp.

I would date the amp's birth to late 74 or early 75, but the best way to pin it down would be by the date code on the speakers.
