Its not likly that the effect is made to be on all the time with out the footswitch, but I can not say for sure, hell the amp could have been miswired from day one! Take a guitar cord plut it in the foot switch jack a short across the other end of the cord with a pair of plyers or something, if the tremlo goes off then make or buy a foot switch.
